



KAMLOOPS INVITATIONAL SOCCER TOURNAMENT

Rules of the Tournament

1. You must check into the draw desk located at the beer garden on Mac Island field #5 prior to your first game. There will be a waiver form that must be signed by all players and handed into the desk. Note, the desk will be open Friday night from 6:00PM to 10:00PM. It is highly recommended that you check-in on Friday night as opposed to Saturday prior to your game.
2. You may have a total of 21 players on your team roster.
3. In order to play in a FINALS game (i.e. A-final, B-final, A-consolation final), a player must have played in one tournament game prior to the final.
4. Players are allowed to play for only one (1) team in the tournament.
5. If a player receives 3 yellow cards, the player will be required to miss one game.
6. If a player receives 2 yellow cards in the same game, the player will have to miss the next scheduled game.
7. A red card offence will result in a minimum one game suspension or as reviewed by the discipline committee. **IT IS THE PLAYER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO CHECK WITH THE TOURNAMENT DRAW DESK TO CONFIRM THE NUMBER OF GAMES HE/SHE IS SUSPENDED FOR.** Should a player play a game where he was suspended, the opposition will receive an automatic 1-0 win.
8. In regards to protests, the discipline committee will deal with any situation that may arise during the tournament. However, please refrain from bringing small issues to the draw desk unless you absolutely feel your team or player was unfairly treated. Note, every official protest will cost \$25.00.
9. In order to receive your round robin prize money, you must collect a special slip from the referee and deliver the slip to the draw desk.
10. **POINT SYSTEM** - The tournament will be using the following point system for all teams to determine pool and division placements:
 - a) 6 points for a win
 - b) 3 points for a tie
 - c) 1 point for a shutout
 - d) 1 point for each goal scored to a maximum of three (3).

For example, if you win 3-0, your team will receive 10 points for that game. If your team won 2-1, your team will receive 8 points and the losing team will receive 1 point.
11. Round robin placements and divisional rankings will be based on the following criteria:
 - a) Most points in round robin play
 - b) If tied, record versus other team in pool
 - c) Most wins
 - d) Best goal differential(goals for - goals against)
 - e) Most goals for
 - f) If teams are still tied after the above criteria, the teams involved will draw straws to determine who will advance.

Rules of the Tournament

12. All round robin games are two (2) thirty-five (35) minute halves long. Games that are tied after regulation play will remain a draw.
13. Games on Sunday that require a winner will go directly into penalty kicks if tied after 70 minutes.
14. All A-FINAL games on Monday that are tied after 70 minutes will go into an extra 10 minute golden goal overtime period. If the game is still tied after the 10-minute period, the game will be decided by penalty kicks. All other finals (Consolation and B-Final), will go into penalty kicks.
15. Teams that are **NOT PREPARED** to play a game final (i.e. B- final or A-consolation final) will not be paid their prize payout for that game.
16. **NO-SHOWS:** If a team is a 'no-show' for a game, the remaining team is awarded a 2-0 win (i.e. 9 points).
17. Players must be a minimum of sixteen (16) years old to be eligible to play subject to division age restrictions, if applicable. The KIST Society reserves the right to require proof of age.
18. **CO-ED DIVISIONS:** A minimal of three (3) women must be on the field at all times (not including the goalkeeper, who can be either male or female).
19. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages to be consumed outside of the beer garden.
